Please be advised that funding applications are available through the Morris County Department of Human Services. Anticipated 2015 funding is intended for the provision of services identified within Morris County planning documents.

A Request for Funding Application (RFA) must be submitted to be considered for 2015 funding for the following:

- **Juvenile Justice Funding** – Community based services for at-risk juveniles or to prevent juvenile delinquency
- **Peer Grouping** – To prevent premature institutionalization for the elderly and/or disabled

The RFA package for the above funding sources is now available. The package will contain detailed information regarding the application process, including a funding priorities summary and instructions for completing the RFA.

For 2015, the following funding streams are in a renewal year; however, new applications will be considered: \*

- **Chapter 51** – State funding for substance abuse prevention, education and treatment
- **Child Abuse Prevention** - Education model geared toward the family
- **Older Americans Act Funding** – designated to provide services in Access, Home, Community and Nutrition support for people age 60 years and their caregivers
- **Grant-in-Aid** – County funding for the areas of mental health, substance abuse, aging, veterans, disabilities, youth services and general human services.

*\*Programs currently supported by these funding streams will receive 2015 renewal applications by mail.*

**PLEASE NOTE:** Since the completed applications for 2015 funding are due by **4:30 p.m., June 27, 2014**, it is recommended that you submit the worksheet as soon as possible.
