

## 2018 Grant in Aid

Grant in Aid (GIA), the investment of County tax dollars, continues to be the largest annual funding source for community-based services administered by the Department. This funding was established in 1978 to support Saint Clare's E.T. Dutton counseling Center and has grown to stretch across a broad continuum of services.

GIA is the most versatile funding stream administered by the Department. In addition to frequently serving as support funds, it is often a source of funding for innovative programs that do not precisely fit the funding guidelines of other sources.

Morris County GIA supports priority human service programs which serve specific target populations identified within the County service planning documents.
